The Twentieth Century Club Foundation of Park Ridge will again give out scholarships to deserving students who will attend college in the fall of 2022. These students must submit the application form and all other requested documents so that they are received by March 31, 2022. The students must live in Park Ridge and attend an accredited high school.

Please note that while academic achievements are considered, these are not the sole basis for giving these scholarships. Students who can demonstrate their financial need in the application should apply. Students who are interested in varied courses of study are eligible. Those who study art, music, culinary courses and the like will be considered.

The awards will be based on financial need, extra-curricular involvement in school and in the community, and scholastic merit. We are seeking a diverse pool of applicants and those showing demonstrable need.

Application Information and Requirements

Since 2005, the Twentieth Century Club Foundation has awarded scholarships to deserving seniors who live in Park Ridge and are graduating from an accredited high school. This year we will award scholarships of \$1,000 to \$2,000 each. The award will be based on financial need, extra-curricular involvement in school and in the community, and scholastic merit.

Your completed application must include the following:

1. The attached Scholarship Application Form first page, completed and signed.
2. Your official school transcript. Make sure it is legible. Black out the social security number if provided.
3. An essay discussing why you need this scholarship and how it will affect your college experience. Clearly state your financial need.
4. A separate paragraph giving a short biography about your family.
5. A separate sheet of paper listing:
 - a. Work experience during the last three years, including dates and the number of hours per week that you work.
 - b. Activities and volunteer opportunities in which you participate outside of school, including dates and the number of hours per week that you participated;
 - c. Six of your most significant extracurricular school activities, years of participation and the approximate number of hours spent per week and weeks per year on each activity;
 - d. Awards you have received. Include community awards and recognition.
6. Two letters of recommendation. These letters are to be submitted directly to the Scholarship Committee at the P.O. Box address listed below or to the email address given below to be received by March 31, 2022. The letters may not be from relatives.
 - a. One letter, not to exceed one page, must be from a high school teacher.
 - b. Another letter, not to exceed one page, must be from someone outside of school such as a pastor, work supervisor, community leader, neighbor, etc.

All materials, including the letters of recommendation, must be mailed or emailed to the Twentieth Century Club Foundation. All documents must be received through email or postal service by March 31, 2022.

- a. Parts 1 through 5 must be submitted by you in one mailing or email. Part 6 will be submitted by the recommenders separately. Parts 1 through 6 are all required to complete the application.
- b. An incomplete application or an application received after the deadline will not be considered.

Money awards are for the 2022-23 school year. If, for any reason, you do not enroll or if you withdraw from the course work, the monies must be refunded.
